

RFP # 12 -2023 Family Support Services, C14 Questions and Answers

1. Budget- As we currently provide all three services (Intervention, Support and Safety) and are submitting applications to continue providing all three services, can we submit one budget for each RFP that covers all three services?

NWFHN will need a separate budget by service, provider may allocated percentage of FTE in each service as well as all other allowable costs.

2. You talk about the well supported evidence based programs in this section, listing three that will be given preference. As PAT and NFP don't serve families with children over 5, and Homebuilders is so expensive to implement and is not accepting any new programs right now, Would you consider the use of another well supported evidence based practice that is not on the list in the RFP?

Yes, other programs can be considered but preference will be given to the evidence based practices listed in the RFP that have been identified by the Clearing House for implementation of Family Support Services.

3. Do you want us to write the RFP through the lens of the evidence based practice program we choose?

The RFP should be written through the lens of services your agency can provide the services that are outlined in the RFP.

4. Staffing – As we currently provide all three services (Intervention, Support and Safety) and are submitting applications to continue providing all three services, can we submit staffing patterns for each RFP that resemble our current staffing pattern with the only change adding new counties Bay and Gulf to the proposals?

NWFHN will need separate staffing patterns by service, provider may allocate a percentage of the FTE in each service as well.
