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## Policy

It is the policy of NWF Health Network to mandate Case Management Organizations (CMOs) to put forth reasonable efforts to reunify any child with an out-of-home safety plan as promptly as is possible and once appropriate pursuant CFOP 170-7 Chapter 12 and in accordance with SB 664. Reunification is active as of the date the child returns to the home with an in-home safety plan.

- A. Procedure in accordance to SB 664: A Progress Update shall be used to assess the parent(s) protective capacities, home environment and backgrounds for Reunification.
- B. Within 10 business days of starting a Progress Update to reunify, the child welfare professional must update local criminal history checks, including required fingerprint submission for any household members 18 years of age or older.
