Policy

It is the policy of NWF Health Network (NWFHN) to ensure timely, coordinated, and documented efforts to secure appropriate community placement for individuals identified on the State Mental Health Treatment Facility (SMHTF) Seeking Placement List (SPL).

NWFHN, through its Operations Team, shall maintain active oversight of all individuals on the SPL by coordinating with SMHTF staff and community providers to support discharge planning and placement efforts. All activities must demonstrate continuous and documented efforts toward placement in alignment with Department of Children and Families (DCF) requirements.

All placement-related activities, including outreach, coordination, follow-up, and identified barriers, shall be documented in the DCF-designated tracking system to ensure accountability, transparency, and compliance.

Procedure

A. To support this policy, NWFHN shall ensure:

1. **Timely Review and Notification**
Individuals newly added to the SPL are reviewed within established timeframes, and appropriate providers are promptly notified to initiate placement efforts.
2. **Ongoing Coordination**
Active collaboration is maintained with SMHTF staff and community providers to identify, pursue, and secure appropriate placement options, including addressing barriers and exploring alternatives when necessary.
3. **Continued Monitoring**
Individuals remaining on the SPL are subject to ongoing follow-up, including routine communication and participation in treatment and discharge planning activities, as appropriate.
4. **Escalation of Barriers**
Persistent barriers to placement are elevated through appropriate channels, including internal leadership review and engagement with facility or state-level partners when necessary.
5. **Documentation and Accountability**
All placement-related activities and efforts are documented in accordance with DCF requirements to demonstrate continuous engagement and compliance with applicable guidance.
